¹ Effective Fall 2008, Hazardous Materials Operations is required for Firefighter I certification (in accordance with the 2008 edition of NFPA 1001, Firefighter Professional Qualifications). All Firefighter I and Firefighter II students who have not previously completed Hazardous Materials Operations training must attend one of the listed sections to be eligible for certification.

² Associate Degree-level and AHA-discipline courses available through online registration only.

³ Schedule is for classroom/didactic portion only. Clinical and/or field hours are scheduled separately on days and times other than those reserved for the classroom/didactic portion of the course. *Students must successfully complete a criminal background check, mandatory health care requirements, and submit availability for scheduling by a specific due date (as provided in class) before participating in required clinicals. Failure to meet these requirements will preclude the student from successfully completing the respective EMS program.*
